Parks and Recreation Ontario Announces CEO Leadership Transition

Toronto, ON (February 9, 2026) – Parks and Recreation Ontario (PRO) announced today that Kim Gavine will retire from her role as Chief Executive Officer, after several years of dedication and outstanding leadership. The Board of Directors has appointed Sarah Ane as the organization's Acting Chief Executive Officer, effective March 1, 2026.
